Traditionally in Northern Europe, oak floorboards were washed with caustic lime to help preserve the timbers and protect them from bugs. Over time, the distinctive chalky wash of residual lime on the oak came to be more appreciated for its beauty than its protective qualities. Today, the lime-washed look is still central to the Scandi-style but is also seen within a wide range of interior styles across the world.



European Oak

From the palaces of Northern Europe to the chateaux of France, European Oak has been a traditional and luxurious flooring choice for centuries. In the Quercus or Oak genus, there are over 500 different species. European Oak is a description that covers several valued oak species that grow in the forests that still cover around 35% of Europe's land area.









Danish Oak

Long before steel became the preferred material for shipbuilding, the Danish naval fleet was dependent on oak, with up to 2000 mature trees required for a single ship. We sourced samples of these classic timbers and their story is now retold in beautifully replicated oak flooring. Danish oak is recognised as a high quality timber that is used in building, furniture and flooring.









Concrete Once the favoured finish of avant-garde architects and experimental designers, concrete today is a shining star throughout the world of design. It's a material of many moods – playing it cool in hardedged contemporary design or bringing a surprising warmth, fluidity and character to a range of interior styles. The concrete look is no longer viewed as something grey and dull. Our team have experimented with different colouring techniques to bring you a collection of inspired luxury vinyl flooring that brings depth, character and a new warmth and elegance to the popular look of concrete.

GreenRate is a straight Type 1 eco label developed to meet the requirements of specific green building rating tools. It includes indoor environmental air quality: volatile organic compounds compliant (IEQ VOC) and reduced exposure to pollutants. GreenRate is offered in three levels of quality from Level 'C' up to Level 'A' relevant to GreenStar in Australia and New Zealand.

Karndean Designflooring LVT ranges and adhesives are fully certified under GreenStar GreenRate Level 'A', plus under international FloorScore Indoor Air Quality Certification for low emitting VOC's. Also certified to LCARate "silver streamline".

Transferable purchase warranty

To qualify for a transferable purchase warranty, you must:

- Adhere to the terms and conditions outlined in the transferable purchase warranty
- Purchase from one of our retail partners and they will provide us with your email address to enable us to send you your transferable purchase warranty

For more information or to obtain your transferable purchase warranty, please speak with your local flooring retailer or contact our Customer Service Team.

The lifetime residential warranty is defined as 35 years and protects against product wear out and manufacturing defects. What's more, the warranties are now transferable to any future owners subject to the terms and conditions of the Transferable Purchase Warranty)




